A graduate of Southwestern University School of Law, with a Bachelor of Science in Zoology from North Carolina State University, Ms. Tenerowicz has been a member of the California State Bar since December 2008.

Ms. Tenerowicz began her legal career in 2008 as a litigation associate in San Francisco, representing clients in commercial, products liability, and other tort matters throughout all phases of litigation, while also maintaining an active pro bono practice assisting tenants seeking disability-related accommodations and representing incarcerated individuals in civil rights matters under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. After becoming a partner in 2016, she transitioned her practice to cybersecurity and, in 2017, joined a global technology company as in-house counsel, where she advised on incident response, audits, investigations, and global compliance initiatives.

The Court is excited to welcome Ms. Tenerowicz to this important role and to continue supporting the Calaveras community through the essential services provided by the Office of the Family Law Facilitator.
